


## Cookies Policy

BOWIL Biotech Sp. z o.o.

1. The following Cookies Policy with the Privacy Policy define the rules of processing and protecting the users personal data of [www.bowil.pl](http://www.bowil.pl) website.
2. The Cookies Policy complies with the legal requirements under Art. 173 of the Telecommunications Law of July 16, 2004 (Journal of Laws of 2021, item 576, as amended) and the Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council (EU) 2016/679 of April 27, 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC of April 27, 2016. "General Data Protection Regulation" (Official Journal of the EU L No. 119, p. 1).
3. Definitions and terms used in the Cookies Policy:
  - a. **Administrator:** the owner of [www.bowil.pl](http://www.bowil.pl) website BOWIL Biotech Sp. z o.o. 7 Skandynawska Street, 84-120 Władysławowo, Poland.
  - b. **User:** any person who visits the [www.bowil.pl](http://www.bowil.pl) website including all subpages.
  - c. **Website:** [www.bowil.pl](http://www.bowil.pl)
  - d. **Cookies:** IT data, in particular text files, stored in the User's devices and intended for use of the Website. The files usually contain the name of the website from which they originate, the time they are stored on the User's device and randomly generated unique number used to identify the browser from which the connection to the Website is made.
4. The Administrator declares that the Website does not collect any information about the User, except for the information contained in Cookies:
  - a. to collect standard web log information and save information of Users in anonymous form,
  - b. to evaluate using the Website by Users also to create reports and aggregated statistics on the Website activity,
  - c. to adapt the Website content and to optimize using the Website suited to the User's individual preferences.
5. The Website uses two main types of Cookies:
  - a. the temporary files are stored on the User's device until the end of the session or closing web browser,
  - b. the permanent files are stored on the User's device for the time specified in the Cookies parameters or until their removal by the User.



6. The Website also uses the following types of Cookies:
  - a. enabling the use of services available on the Website, such as Cookies used for services requiring authentication within the Website,
  - b. to ensure security, e.g. used to detect fraud in the authentication within the Website,
  - c. enabling to remember the User's selected settings and personalize the User's interface, e.g. regarding the language or region,
  - d. enabling to collect the information about the use of the Website by User,
  - e. enabling the delivery of advertising content more tailored to User's interests.
7. Each User may independently determine the conditions of storage or access to Cookies in the browser preferences at any time, e.g. partially restrict or completely disable the storage of Cookies. Limiting the use of Cookies may influence the correctness of the website functioning.
8. If the User does not agree to the data processing by the Administrator obtained via Cookies, the User should change the browser settings in his devices.
9. Lack of blocking Cookies in the web browser is equal to providing consent for processing User's personal data by the Administrator obtained via Cookies.
